I did try it for our State Tournament and it worked great, but I also used HS Master as the main database. You will need a login in eShoe to use this feature; let me know if you are interested to learn and I can help you get a Login.

Melanie had a great time at Huntsman Senior Games this year in October and encouraged any who can to come participate in a fun Singles and Doubles Tournament. We also went to the Western Open in St. George and had a good time, but we didn't play very well. They had 100 players for the first time. It is held the 2nd Friday & Saturday in November each year.

I also hope that the 2025 World Tournament in Sandy, Utah is on your radar and that you get your 4 tournaments in and register for it as soon as you can. We are offering a reduced fee if you enter by January 31, 2025 and then the fee will increase on February 1, 2025. This is to help with increased

## Regional Director & HOF Reports



Well, as we close out another season of horseshoe pitching one change that was made at the World Tournament this year is that the elders women (ages 65 and older) now get to recognize the 20 foot foul line instead of 27 foot foul line.

In Idaho we may have a new

pitching facility back up and running for the 2025 season and beyond. The Kellogg facility was used back in the nineties and hosted the 1996 State Singles plus other tournaments. Laurie Dale has promised me that she will be working with the proper individuals to bring the pegs and such up to code so they can be sanctioned in order to run tournaments. With this added city and location we also hope to build our membership.

On another note, I encourage all clubs to schedule their tournaments for the 2025 season as soon as possible, getting them to me by March 1<sup>st</sup>. We need them submitted in time for the spring newsletter. With World being in Salt Lake this year, a few extra tournaments may be needed to meet the required number of tournaments to enter.

I've been in contact with Ben Webb, the new NHPA President, and there is an early reduced fee to register for World if done by January 31, 2025.

As for the Hall of Fame, we did not induct anyone this year, but I hope to in 2025 and not wait for 2026.

## 2024 Idaho State Horseshoe Pitching Association Annual Meeting Minutes

The Idaho State Horseshoe Pitching Association Annual Meeting was held on September 7, 2024 in Meridian, Idaho. State President Brian Poole called the meeting to order at 1:35pm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was bypassed due to having said it at the beginning of the tournament.

The minutes of the 2023 Annual Meeting were approved.

Brian discussed the NHPA rule changes from the World Tournament in Kennewick, WA in July of 2024:

### PBC-1

This proposal is changing the number of delegates that a charter gets for the convention. The old rule was you get one delegate for every charter then you got another for every 100 members. This new proposal charters get one delegate for every 50 members to increase the number of delegates at the NHPA annual Delegate meeting. This proposal PASSED.

#### PBC-2

This proposal added the note that no nominations from the floor of the convention if there are any established candidates who have submitted their candidacy per the bylaws. This proposal PASSED.

#### PBC-3

This proposal was to move the vote back to the delegates to select future World Tournament sites. This proposal FAILED. The WT sites will be selected by the NHPA council.

### PBC-4

This proposal is moving the date for Rule & Bylaw proposal changes from September 30 and changing it to February 1 of the voting year. This proposal PASSED.

## PRC-1

This proposal was changing the Cadet aged from 12 to 10 to align with the ages from elementary and middle school age kids. This proposal FAILED. The Cadet age will stay at 12.

## PRC-2

This proposal was adding a new pitching Division for Elder Woman. At age 65 they can choose to move to this division and observe the 20 ft foul line. This proposal PASSED. A new division will be added to eShoe for his new division. More details to come from the NHPA council as they make this change to the Rules.

Financial report by Melanie Poole. It was moved by Dave Spears, seconded by Laurie Dale, and approved.

Officers Reports: Mike Beall and Evan Pickett did not have anything to report.

## **Dave Spears-Regional Director/Hall of Fame Report:**

There are no inductees in the Hall of Fame this year.

Kellogg is willing to bring their courts up to date and to be sanctioned.

## Correspondence:

A motion was made to pay Kay Keskinen \$100 for managing the website and doing the newsletter. Motion Passed

### **Election of Officers:**

2nd VP is currently held by Mike Beall who was nominated for this position. Laurie Dale moved to have nominations cease, Ray Carpenter seconded it. Mike Beall will continue as 2nd VP by acclamation.

The position of President is currently held by Brian Poole. Pep Plummer nominated Carol Plummer. Mike Beall nominated Brian Poole and Stew seconded it. While Melanie was distributing voting slips Carol withdrew her nomination. Brian Poole will continue as President by acclamation.

### **New Business:**

Jim Price will draft a letter to invite people back to join the NHPA/ISHPA who have not been pitching to hopefully increase our numbers as well as support the World Tournament being held so close in Salt Lake City. Jim will get his draft letter to Melanie and we will get it sent out.

Dave Spears offered to create an incentive plaque to be given to the person who brings in the most new players.

2025 State Doubles will be held in Pocatello at Ross Park. Date to be determined.

Next year State Singles will be held in North Idaho. If the Kellogg courts can be sanctioned, we may play there. If not, it will be held in Coeur d'Alene.

Laurie Dale will sponsor and pay their \$25 and Idaho & \$7.00 for any youth from ID who will be pitching at the World Tournament in Kennewick in 2027.

We had group pictures and class photos taken.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:19pm.



## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

NHPA membership is a combined membership of the state and the national horseshoe pitching associations. This membership entitles you to participate in NHPA sanctioned play throughout the United States and much of Canada, wherever you meet the event requirements. You must pay your dues through the state charter where you maintain legal residence as determined by where you vote and pay taxes.

Dues are based on the calendar year. New members may pay next year's dues after October 1st of the current year and will be eligible to participate in sanctioned events for the final 3 months of the current year, as well as all of the next year. As a member of the Idaho Charter, you will receive newsletters and a schedule of all sanctioned and some non-sanctioned tournaments for the state.

Your NHPA membership card number will be six digits. If you join through your charter membership director the first two digits are the region (Idaho is region 08) followed by four digits. If you join on the Eshoe link at the NHPA web site your membership number will be randomly generated. Your membership number will remain with you while you maintain your membership, even if you move to another state.

NHPA/ISHPA dues may be paid online using PayPal or a credit/debit card on the Eshoe link at the NHPA web site. If you choose to pay dues locally, please fill in all information on the form below that applies to you and mail along with total amount of dues to the ISHPA Sec./Treas. If you have an e-mail address, please print it clearly. Please make checks payable to: ISHPA. (send to Melanie's address shown below)

Your pitching stats from all sanctioned events go to the NHPA stats headquarters. Stats are updated after each sanctioned tournament and can be accessed through the Eshoe Events app on the NHPA website.
