The NHPA card is a combination membership of the State Charter and the National Horseshoe Pitching Association. This membership entitles you to participate in any NHPA sanctioned tournament throughout the United States and much of Canada, wherever you meet the requirements of the event. You must pay your dues through the state charter where you maintain legal residence as determined by your legal residence.

New Members may pay next year's dues after Oct. 1st of the current year and will be eligible to participate in sanctioned events for the final 3 months of the current year, as well as all of the next year. As a member of the Idaho Charter, you will receive newsletters and a schedule of all sanctioned and some non-sanctioned tournaments in Idaho.

Your pitching stats from all sanctioned events will be forwarded to the NHPA stats headquarters called NHPA-eShoe. These stats are updated instantly when tournaments are downloaded to eShoe and can be accessed through the NHPA-eShoe website. You can also print your NHPA card from eShoe.
